Arthur R. Hand, age 79, of Peoria, passed away the morning of April 6, 2023 at OSF Saint Francis Medical Center. He was surrounded by his family after a hard fought battle. He was born on March 30, 1944 in Peoria to Leroy and Evelyn (St. Clair) Hand. He married Sandra (Sandy) Clark on June 27, 1964 with whom he made a home for over 58 years.
