December 4, 1961 - December 8, 2023

Bloomington, IN – Dr. Douglas Bright, 62, passed away on Friday morning, December 8th at the OSF Richard L. Owens Hospice Home in Peoria, IL after a battle with cancer.

Doug was born in Salem, IL on December 4th, 1961, the son of Harold and Wanda (nee Burnam) Bright. He was preceded in death by his mother. 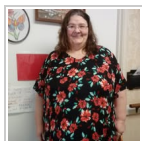
