BARTONVILLE- Jack H. Miller, Jr., 71, of Bartonville passed away on Friday, May 14, 2021 at home.

For close to 30 years, Jack has lived with cancer. He dealt with multiple rounds of chemotherapy, radiation, and surgeries, but seemingly was indestructible. Through his fight with cancer, Jack was an incredible example of work ethic, toughness, and strength. Jack would often say that cancer would not kill him, and he was proven correct. Ultimately, his heart gave out and he passed peacefully. If you were lucky enough to know Jack, you had a loyal friend for life.
