Cremation has been accorded. Services have been entrusted to Schmidt-Haller Burial and Cremation Services.



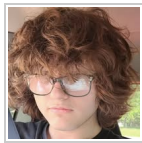

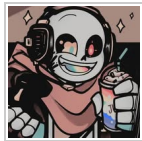

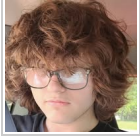
