Kevin William Tilton, 70, of Bartonville, Illinois, born February 4, 1954, died peacefully on September 26, 2024.

Kevin was preceded in death by his parents William Boyd Tilton and Joanna Windsor Tilton.

In his free time, he was an avid reader, a horse-racing aficionado, and a St. Louis Cardinals fan. He will be remembered by his family for his devotion to his wife, his boundless charm, and his enduring sense of humor.
