



## Leonard Wade Matheny

May 15, 1957 - April 20, 2026

Leonard Wade Matheny, 68, of Dunlap, passed away on Monday, April 20, 2026.

He was born on May 15, 1957 to Janice (Hurst) and Wade Matheny. He married his high school sweetheart, Vicki (Balzell) Matheny on June 5, 1976, and was looking forward to celebrating their 50th wedding anniversary in a few weeks. Together, they had two children, Wendy (Navid) Samadani-Matheny and Justin (Andrea) Matheny. He was the proudest Papa to his three adored grandbabies, Evie (10), Lily (8), and Matthew (20 months).

He was preceded in death by his parents and sisters, Linda Crews and Diane Miller. He is survived by his wife, children, paternal uncle, Joe (Jan) Matheny, and maternal aunt, Sue Hurst.

Leonard was a longstanding member of the First Church of the Brethren of Peoria where he lived his faith through a variety of roles - from beloved Sunday school teacher and youth leader, to properties chair and sound system operator. He served the broader Church of the Brethren through both Illinois-Wisconsin District and Annual Conference activities.

He was a proud graduate and 1975 class president of Woodruff High School, a Boy Scout leader and troop-master, a devoted volunteer to Mountain Mission in southeast Kentucky, and lover of the outdoors who found joy riding his bike for miles and miles on his own and with friends. As a Caterpillar employee, he climbed the ladder from a third shift pneumatic chipper to Group Manager of the Cast Metals Organization over the course of his 38-year career.

A celebration of life will be held at the First Church of the Brethren of Peoria (4714 N. Sheridan Rd.) on Saturday, April 25, 2026. A visitation will be held from 9:00-11:00 am, followed by a brief memorial service at 11:00am, and lunch in the church fellowship hall.

In lieu of flowers, the family welcomes donations in Leonard's memory to the First Church of the Brethren of Peoria with a note designating "Mountain Mission," or a donation to the OSF Cancer Institute that cared for him so well in his final months.
