Mark A Shaner, age 64 of Peoria IL passed away on Thursday May 28th 2026 in his home mostly likely due to complications related to this diabetes (low glucose) after suffering a seizure, stroke, and/or a heart attack. Mark had spent a large amount of the last few years in nursing homes and hospital stays where his right leg was amputated just below the knee due to a severe infection and being hospitalized after a severe seizure and unconsciousness where his was paralyzed on his left (good leg) side that he did not fully regain for about 3 days and left him with a foot drop issue (just got a brace for it 2 days).

Mark married Paula Davis-Shaner on March 3rd 1996, who survives him. Mark was a graduate of Woodruff High School and he meet Paula while working as a school bus driver in Peoria. He passed away in bed with his two “boyz” (dogs) named Beethoven and Bandit lying next to him.

Mark has had a number of other jobs over the years including jobs at a buffet including meat carver, and yard maintenance.
