Michael Eugene McCleery, 72, of Pekin, Illinois, passed away at home on October 26, 2023 after a 9 month battle with a ruptured AVM. Mike was born to Ellis McCleery and Mildred Louise McCleery on June 20, 1951. He married Glenda S Huffhines on May 20, 1986 in Pekin, IL and she preceded him in death on November 21, 2016. Mike was also preceded in death by his parents, and grandson Koby M Guengerich.
