August 15, 1948 - June 28, 2025

Nancy Jane Gross, 76, of Sparland entered the presence of the Lord on Saturday, June 28, 2025.

Nancy was born Aug. 15, 1948, in Harrisburg, Pa. She married James B. Gross on Aug. 31, 1969, at the United Methodist Church in Cleona, Pa. He survives.

Also surviving are her daughters, Tami (and Mark) Tiller of Huntington, W. Va., and Mindy (and Brock) Elsasser of Sparland; and her four grandchildren, Zac, Nic, Henry, and Leila.

Nancy was a devoted teacher at Dallas Independent School District in Dallas, Texas, Christian Heritage in Cedar Falls, Iowa, Peoria Christian School in Peoria, and Sunbury Christian Academy in Northumberland, Pa., where she later became the Administrator. While teaching, she was honored as one of 19 teachers to be awarded the Excellence in Teaching by The Perot Foundation.

Nancy became a Christian as a teen when she responded to an altar call. Throughout her life, her faith remained very important to her. She was often found spending time outside with her devotions.
