Pat Heffren, known to her friends and family as Pat, Patty Ann, Ma and Grandma, passed away at OSF Richard Owens Hospice Home in Peoria, Illinois on November, 19, 2022. Mom beat cancer 3 times and while she didn't beat it this time, she out ran it with dignity, grace and a warrior spirit.

Patricia Ann Hopkins was born at St. Francis Hospital in Peoria, Illinois on January 25th, 1943 to James Dale and Edith Mae (Schiabbe) Hopkins. She was preceded in death by her parents and her sister Nadine Mayberry.
