Ralph Eugene Sommer, 86, of East Peoria, IL, passed away Thursday, Sept. 14, 2023, surrounded by his devoted wife and loving family.

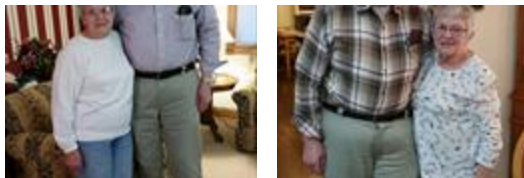
