Randall L. "Randy" Baker, age 58, of Peoria, passed away Tuesday, May 24, 2022 at 7:47 a.m. at his residence.

He was born June 13, 1963 in Peoria to Larry and Janet (Asbury) Baker. He married Corine Braman on May 7, 1983 in East Peoria.
