Robert J. "Bob" Lancaster-Hugel, 77, of Chillicothe, passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, February 27, 2023. He was born in Peoria on June 16, 1945, a son of John and Bertha (Bergman) Hugel. Bob and Bryan Misner were together for 45 years, and married in October 2017. He survives.
