Thomas Lee Dentino of Peoria, IL, passed away on Sunday, January 15, 2023, at the age of 66. He was born on April 11, 1956.

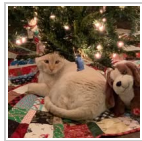

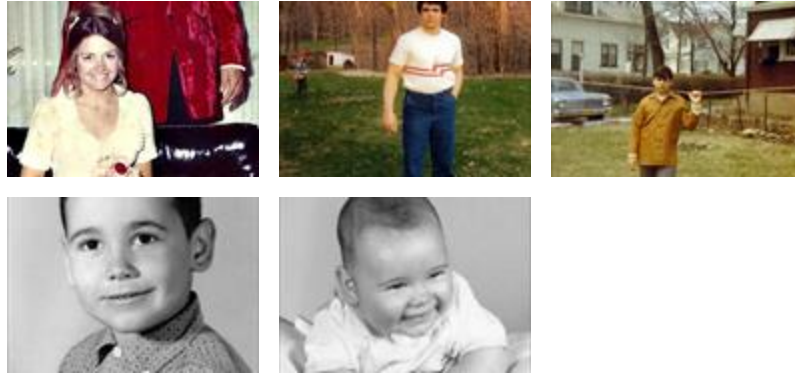
